

Garver Arts Incubator Artist Information

The Garver Arts Incubator will create and support an inclusive community of working artists by providing:

- Affordable, well designed studios
- Business assistance
- Shared equipment
- Gallery space
- Conference and workshop rooms

The facility will offer artists a unique opportunity to promote and sell their work in an exciting public space. Visitors will come to the Garver Arts Incubator to interact directly with working artists. They will have the opportunity to watch a potter throw, talk to a painter about technique, take a class in book making or purchase a hand-blown vase directly from the artist.

The Garver Arts Incubator programming will include:

- Classes for the public
- Lectures
- Gallery openings
- Open studio events
- Artist in residence

Studio Space

The Garver Arts Incubator will have 40 art studios ranging in size from 190 – 1,600 square feet and a 2,900 square feet 2-story performance/practice space with an observation balcony.

Seven of the arts studios (Type 2) are designed to accommodate 3D art media that includes: blacksmithing/metalworking, glass blowing, woodworking/woodcarving, sculpture and ceramics. These are larger studios that are located on the 1st floor. A shared kiln room is located at the east end of the 1st floor and is designed to handle special ventilation needs.



Thirty three of the art studios (Type 1) are designed for 2D art media that includes: fiber, painting, drawing, writing, digital photography, digital media and

printmaking. These studios are generally smaller and located on the 3rd floor and have natural light provided by exterior windows or skylights.

All artists will have access to a collaboration room for joint projects and a break room located on the 3rd floor. A receiving dock on the 1st floor will accommodate freight deliveries for the building and a freight elevator will serve all three floors.

Studio rent will be affordable and is currently set at \$10/square feet plus a prorated share of utilities. Depending on studio size, base rent would range between \$158 - \$1,333 per month. Performance space rent will also be set at an affordable hourly rate.
